Misc. Notes

21.xii.86 65a. Kepırı Diriği Mevkisi, Bozhöyük.

On next hill to west (imm. opposite höyük) (c. 400 m), small qty of sherds and Roman tile seen. Villagers said they ploughed sherds out here. From localised concentration and fact that most of field soil is utterly sterile it would seem that this area prob. contains only graves. Some bone fragments seen. Nothing collected.

Aslanoğlu, info. from villagers

Bridge - Holi Tarlası Kaldurma deresi - area where sherds are found.

Mergzer Harabası - (66).

Safarbolu - kale not fully ^{searched} searched for.

Amasra - main defences pre-date Genoese work as appear contemporary with churches. Fortifications probably early - mid Byz with outer wall, ? walls. Complex ^{Complex} outworks at W end. Byzantine buildings other than churches. Bedesten visited.

Zara - confusion about new name.

1. Aktaş, taken SE of Keşanlı near Davutköy. ^{rut} Some column frags, inscription on column outside Davutköy cami. Other frags. ^{settlement} Classical settlement. 1 piece from church. Old name Sora.

2. Zara now Sopranta. ~~Also~~ some classical frags as Hellenistic tomb with stone ^{door} very recently 'dozed'. Nearby Kale höy - more stones, capital & inscription; also trace of medieval walls. ^{inscription}

Çeşme, On main W road, near İlk okul, stone fragments built into walls as 2 church window uprights. ^{uprights} Confirm ^{Ainsworth's} 'guard houses'. Also tympanum with sculpture from village nearby. ^{tympanum}

Kuşuklu. old name Kavacaviran, & kale above town.

Kuşonlu. little pottery, but many internal buildings. Selcuk & later settlement elsewhere in town.

Araplar. m.z. ^f Bebek mülkünde.

Red field is E of village above Çalkav çay --
Sırttaki saruk tonlasc - nothing here.. 2 stray shreds.

~~Şehir~~ Geinde Harabası: on Road from Araplar is keditc.
to the R of road as it rises up N. side of Çalkav derese
shreds found here. Villagers produced 2 coins said to be from here
One Byz. (Æ Aron.) One Roman? but very worn.
e triangular AE plate - ? belt buckle - with incised decoration.

Köy tomonları Araplar - 'old' graves on small plateau behind the village
but no shreds or other finds.

Çat. Bani mez. ^{means low garden. low} rot on hilltop but on valley slope.

Sırttaki Keçira simaki is name of site type with site on
low hill.

~~Karabazarcı~~ ^{or} few name. - Çğüred
H. xii. Kuriston village. Rock cut tombs in rocks to N.-E.W of
village on ^E bank of Gök Su. Roman tile, flint (prob natural)

To west - 2 knots of outcrops - both with tombs. (low diff/s e. 2-3m high).

Hemantil Hemantil (new name Sarıkaya) above W. bank of Gök su toward W
east of village steep sided
