Summary: (Event will be in Turkish; Etkinlik Türkçe'dir)

As part of the [WikiGLAM/Turkish Museums](#) Project (page is in Turkish now; English will be created soon; wikidata & queries are in English), Wikimedia Community User Group Turkey ([WMTR](#)), Museum Professionals Association ([MüzeDer](#)) and BIAA are working on creating a linked data infrastructure for museums and ancient sites in Turkey. The aim of this project is to create 'museums in Turkey' directorates and lists in Wikidata for public and private museums, as well as all related organisations, and to assemble all scattered data. In this event, Zafer Batık and Başak Tosun will provide information on the project, and on how to create Wiki data on museums in Turkey. At the end of these workshops, museum professionals and other participants will be able to create and check Wiki data on museums. This will enable creating a tool for other GLAM institutions (libraries, archives and museums) to link their data to museums (GLAM) if relevant. This project is the start of citizen-science project in order to add and verify museum and ancient sites for Turkey.

[Wikipedi:GLAM/Türkiye Müzeleri](#) projesi kapsamında müzeler (açık hava müzeleri dahil) için bağlı veri altyapısı oluşturulmaya çalışılmaktadır (proje sayfası şu an Türkçe alup, yakında İngilizcesi de oluşturulacaktır. Wikidata ve sorgu verileri İngilizce'dir). WMTR, Müzeciler Derneği ve BIAA birlikte çalışarak müzelerle ilgili bağlı veri altyapısını oluşturmaya çalışmaktadır. Proje ile devlet müzeleri, özel müzeler vb olmak üzere müze ve ilgili birimlerin wikidata verileri oluşturulup, dağınık verilerin bir araya getirilmesi amaçlanmaktadır. Yapılacak bu etkinlik ile müzelerle ilgili wiki veri oluşturmak isteyen katılımcılara wikipedi ve proje hakkında bilgi verilecektir. Böylece müze profesyonellerinin ve müzelere ilgi duyan katılımcıların müzelere ilişkin wiki verilerini üretmeleri ve kontrol etmeleri sağlanacaktır. Bu da GLAM olarak belirttiğimiz kütüphane, arşiv müze vb gibi müzelerle ilişkili verileri olan kurum ve kuruluşların verilerini bağlı veri yapıları için bir araç olabilecektir. Proje, müzelere ilişkin veri ekleme ve doğrulama konusunda bir vatandaş-bilimi projesi başlangıcı olacaktır.

Bio:

Başak Tosun was born in Adana in 1977. She obtained her bachelor's in political science and international relations in 1999 from Boğaziçi University. Since 2005, she has been volunteering with Wikimedia Foundation to popularise the creation and sharing of open content. She is one of the founding members of the Wikimedia Community User Group Turkey and the 'Dijital Bilgi Derneği' foundation. Since 2015, she has been organizing workshops in universities and NGOs, and taking part in organizing collaborations with museums, archives and libraries in order to popularise sharing open digital content. She is particularly passionate about increasing the visibility and the contribution of women as content creators in Wikipedia.

Zafer Batık was born in İzmit in 1978. After graduating from Kocaeli University in 2000, he worked in the smart building market for 19 years. He has been contributing to Wikimedia projects since 2008 and is one of the founding members of the Wikimedia Community User Group Turkey. His usual tasks include checking the latest edits and new entries. He is particularly interested in sports-related entries, and visually enriching Wikipedia with copyright-free, open license images. He is working in his full capacity in the user group projects for increasing the user contributions and establishing new partnerships.

Hakan Melih Aygün is the chairman of the board of directors of Müzeciler Derneği, and a project is coordinator at the General Directorate of Cultural Heritage and Museums of Turkey. He is an anthropologist and ecologist. His interests include implementation of contemporary practices in museum studies, information technologies automation systems, ecological anthropology, and sustainable protection methods of cultural and natural heritage.

Nurdan Atalan Çayırezmez is a Near Eastern Archaeologist currently pursuing a Ph.D. on Information and Records Management at Ankara University. She holds an Ms Degree from Settlement Archaeology at Middle East Technical University.
